## Will You Not Tell It Today?

“And he charged them that they should tell no man: but the more he charged them, so much the more a great deal they published it” (Mark 7:36).

Jesus had just healed a man who was unable to speak. Immediately, He instructed the man and those who brought him to him to tell no one. But they could not stay silent. How ironic that we haven't been commanded to tell no one, but to tell everyone! Yet in all too many cases, we tell no one. The lost need to be told the gospel and the redeemed need to be reminded of the gospel, yet we tell no one!
